## HUSD Board of Trustees Votes to Censure Joe Ramos!

Following joint statements and actions led by HEA and joined by AEOTE and SEIU, the HUSD Board of Trustees followed through on our demands and took action against Trustee Ramos for his hateful and violent remarks made at previous board meetings. In a 4-1 vote to support censure, the board also honored our demands around maintaining safe school sites by removing Ramos from all district committees and banning him from all employee workspaces (including offices and classrooms). Once again, swift and bold action by our unions delivers a victory for everyone.

While this is an important step in our fight for safe schools (and against bigotry and hate), we know this fight will continue. We do not expect Joe Ramos to have the decency to resign his position, despite his obvious unfitness to serve in any position of public trust. Stay tuned for worksite meetings to discuss this further, and we will need everyone to help us elect board members in November that reflect our values and uphold the vision of public education.

Thanks to our members and allies who joined the meeting on Wednesday to support the censure.

As a professional courtesy as well as sharing a true welcome of the student (e.g. a prepared desk, name tags, knowing their name, etc.!), we advocated for at least 24-hours. The district admin provided their practice. It turns out our request wasn't too far off base of what they are supposed to be doing! **The district practice is found here**.
