#### HR Message - Mandated Public Works Training Update

You should have received the <u>attached email from HR</u> regarding the mandated trainings. After speaking with Kim Watts, she agreed that this communication required additional clarification, which should be coming to folks soon. The biggest point that needs to be conveyed is to **WAIT!** Site admin is receiving direction from HR and will advise regarding next steps.

Important points to expect with this upcoming communication:

- Site admin may (and are encouraged to) use staff meeting time to complete the work.
- Site admin may offer to release teachers (e.g. cover classes) for a period of time for teachers to complete the work. Acceptance of this offer is at the discretion of the teacher.
- If the site admin directs you to complete these trainings during your own after school/prep/collaboration time, be sure to <u>get that in writing</u>, because there is no promise that a submitted timecard for this training will be approved for any work completed after today or for work done during prep or collaboration time.
- There is no limit to completing the work. The district believes it is approximately a 2 hour period of time to complete.

That said, if you have already completed these trainings during your own after school/ prep/collaboration time, **submit a timecard**. (Again, this only applies if you have already completed the trainings in this way. After today, these trainings are not to be completed in this way.) **The district said they will arrange for time for the work to be completed. We will wait and see.**

She helped create and pilot the first middle school Puente Project Program. She works with the statewide Puente Project to learn and develop curriculum around language, identity, linguistic justice, and the challenges of A.I. in education. Johnson's teaching philosophy is that great educators must continue to adapt, change, learn, and grow with their students' academic and social needs. 'Every day is different. Every year I can change up what I teach and how I teach it. It's the most fun job. I have zero regrets for switching careers and choosing this one.'" Amazing job, Janette!
