Meeting Details

Come to the <u>Ratification Meeting</u> to vote on our new contract, enjoy delicious tacos and churros, celebrate our victory, hear more about the bargaining experience for this tentative agreement, and participate in a Tentative Contract Q&A.

Voting Details

Voting will be done by **electronic ballot** that will be sent to the personal email address that you have in your <u>CTA Profile</u> (as we did for the recent HEA Board elections). If you are unsure whether we have your current email address on file, please email <u>office@heahayward.org</u>. The electronic ballots will also have the tentative agreement and the salary schedules that reflect the increase attached for members to review during their voting.

The voting for this ratification will be on Friday, April 19th from 4:00pm-6:00pm. Because this window is short, electronic ballots will be <u>emailed at 3:00pm</u> so that members can confirm that they have received their ballots in time for the voting and allow additional time for troubleshooting, if needed. Electronic ballots can only be used once and cannot be shared with others. If you have not received your electronic ballot by 3:30pm, email <u>office@heahayward.org</u>. The HEA Office will be at their computer, ready to support emails that they receive from members. <u>Voting will close at 6:00pm on Friday</u>, April 19th. No exceptions can be made after that time.

Tentative Contract Agreement Highlights

We look forward to sharing the many improvements we were able to negotiate that will improve the lives of Hayward educators and students. More information will follow and highlights include:

- A 2% retroactive salary increase effective July 1, 2022
- An <u>8.5% salary increase</u> effective July 1, 2023
- Partial annual contribution (not on salary schedule) towards health benefits
- Defined minutes of preschool minimum days and provided collaboration time
- Eliminated 3/4 combo classes
- Provided extra pay for Combo assignments
- Improvements to prep time and make up preps
- Improved language to mainstream students, including class size adjustments
- Release time for additional department chairs at middle and high schools
- Improved caseloads and ratios for Special Ed, EL Specialists, OTs, Psychologists, and Nurses
- Improved health and safety conditions, including emergency response procedures and repair timelines
- Changes to simplify the "40-hour" language
- Pay at per diem rates for extra work (instead of hourly rates)
- Improvement in Summer School pay
- And more!

CTA University Credit Program
