Class Size

We would like to give a nod to the HEA Enrollment Team members: Kim Steffen and Julie Rubia for all of their hard work and advocacy for maintaining the current staffing allocations at the sites for the benefits of the teachers and students! The last day to balance classes with the contract limits (Article 12) is **September 7th**. If classes are still over the maximums permissible in the contract, then we will address those through conversations with the district and/or grievances. At the Board Meeting This Past Wednesday

The HUSD Board of Education reviewed their "surplus" sites (what we refer to as the closed sites and our former "school homes") and discussed next steps. The sites list will be going to the Solutions Team (including HEA members: Chantaine Fauntleroy from Bret Harte, Kim Steffen from Cherryland, and Charles Jones from Tennyson) to discuss and make recommendations related to possible use for the location of Bret Harte and the former sites of Bowman, Cherryland, Laurel, and SIAC. Along with considerations for housing (student and teacher), mixed community use, etc. HEA is also advocating for keeping the sites for Community Schools thereby giving us better opportunities to have smaller school populations, smaller class sizes, space for nurse stations, rooms for counselors, etc. We will keep at it.

HEA will have its first Board meeting on Monday, August 28th. We will be discussing, amongst other topics, Conference sponsorships for members, site visits, and site and community organizing . . . all in looking towards membership improvements!
